Minutes of the meeting of Kexby & Scoreby Parish Council Meeting held in Primrose Bank Tea Rooms on Wednesday 15th March 2023 at 7.00pm

1. Apologies for Absence

Councillor Anne Longmore. CYC Ward Councillor Martin Rowley.

2. Declaration of Interests

Nothing noted.

3. Minutes

The council resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on Thursday 15th December 2022 were agreed and signed by the Chairman.

4. Matters Arising from the Minutes

- A. Churchyard – Cllr Daniels advised that the gate will be moved on the 16th March. Update:- The gate was installed on the 22nd March.
- B. Hagg Wood – It was noted that track 19 has now been confirmed and is now part of the definitive map. The clerk was requested to contact Russell Varley, Public Rights of Way Officer @ CYC to enquire as to whether CYC are working with the land owners.
- C. Bus stop, Scoreby Lodge – It was noted that Andrew Dikes has requested CYC to go ahead with the bus stop marking.
- D. Speed limit from Kexby Bridge to Grimston Bar – It was noted that CYC have agreed a temporary 18 month, 40mph speed limit. Cllr Warters to check the length of the agreed section.
- E. Stopping up order – An update was provided by Cllr Mackfall, who advised that the process will now take upto 12 months.
- F. Meadowbank Farm – The email received from CYC Planning was noted. Clerk to enquire as to whether there is a timescale for the planting.

5. Matters Arising Since the Last Meeting

Clerk to report to CYC that the footpath behind Meadowbank Farm has eroded and needs replacing.

Clerk to chase up email sent to CYC regarding the speed and weight limit on Scoreby Lane.

Clerk to chase up CYC for a response on the surrounding for the fire hydrant on the layby outside Ivy House Farm.

Clerk to contact Dave Atkinson @ CYC as to the possible experimental 7.5t weight limit being imposed on Elvington to protect Sutton Bridge having impacts on Kexby with HGVs likely being diverted via Dauby Lane onto the A1079. Clerk to advise CYC that if any such 7.5t weight limit is imposed in Elvington then Kexby PC request that Dauby Lane is similarly restricted.

6. Public Participation

Inspector Lee Pointon attended the meeting and spoke to the parish council about the issue of poaching in the parish. He advised that the task force have been out 9 times in the last month and the drones have been deployed but no poaching activity has been witnessed. Inspector Pointon reiterated that all incident need to be reported and an incident number obtained. He advised that he will put in a bid for the rural task team to visit from August to October when Cllr Wilkinson advised the poaching is at it's worse. Cllr Mackfall raised concerns with police cars using blue lights which only helps to highlight to the poachers that the police are on their way. Inspector Pointon advised that he can request that this is not done in future. It was agreed that either Inspector Pointon or PS Dan Stubbs will attend the September parish council meeting.

Cllr Warters to obtain an Oak tree, with the image of an Oak tree to be added to the other side of the commemorative coin, entitled, 'The

King's Oak'. Cllr Warters to liaise with Cllr Wilkinson as to a suitable location for the tree, close to the bench.

(c) The clerk's annual review was undertaken - no issues were noted.
